Dear Friends,

I have the opportunity of sending you a few lines by Mr. Readin formerly 1st. Sergt of Co. I but now mustered out and on his way home with his wife who has been with the 92nd since it left Potsdam and is firstly entitled to much praise for her persevering energy in sticking by her husband through thick and thin. If they come to see you be sure and keep them over night for they are good friends to me. We are consolidated into 5 companies and our Co. is now Co. A and I am Orderly Sergt. of the Co. The consequence is that just now I have both hands full of business and not much time to write. The boys are all well. Your papers and letters received.
